Instructional & technical program to introduce you to light painting & light drawing at night. Light painting adds light to existing surfaces, whereas light drawing actively creates unique & intriguing content, which can be the main object or addition to a landscape. Jürgen Lobert (MA) Daytime Long Exposure Photography

Introduction to daytime long exposure (DLE) photography. DLE records 1-15 minutes of time by using neutral density filters. This creates unique and intriguing images of the world that we usually freeze in momentary exposures. Letting time pass during exposure converts clouds into bands across the sky, smoothes waters to a mirror finish and can make people and moving objects disappear. The resulting imagery is otherworldly and peaceful. (I, A) (2X) (Sponsored by NESOP)

Sarah Musumeci, MNEC (MA) Pictures to Paintings

After you have completed your standard Photoshop techniques on your favorite image, learn how to take another giant step to enhance your picture by adding oil, water color, and many other painting techniques. (I, A) (2X)

In theory, time-lapse videos are easy to create- you simply take a few hundred photos, one after another, line them up in a video application and done. Not true, if you want to create a stunning, seamless, flicker-free time-lapse video; there is more involved than setting up a camera and capturing the sequence: Learn equipment, camera settings, intervalometer settings, creating quick video using LR, creating video using LR Timelapse (ALL) (2X)

- Each photographer may photograph the model several times over a maximum time of two minutes.
- There will be several different professional constant lighting setups.
- No external flash allowed.
- The type and number of models will be constantly changing to offer a wide range of photo opportunities.

MODEL RELEASE

- Models sign a limited "Model Release" granting permission to participating NECCC attendees to use images taken at the conference for personal use only.
- Personal use is expressly limited to camera club activities as well as personal websites and your personal business card. There are no exceptions to this granting of permission.
- A photograph, print or digital, of a conference model cannot be offered for sale, even at a very inexpensive price.
- All models have been told that they will not sign any model release for any photographer during the
 conference. If the photographer pressures them, models are told to refer that photographer the model
 organizer.

GUIDELINES FOR EMAILING PHOTOS TO MODELS

- Please help the models enhance their portfolios by emailing photos to them.
- Email your processed photos directly to the individual models.
- All the models will have their name and email information available throughout the weekend on a card posted where they are posing.
- Send as many photos as you wish.
- Photos should be sized reasonably for emailing, generally between 1000 to 2000 pixels on the long side.
- As JPEG files.


Attendees can have cafeteria style meals at the Franklin Dining Commons.




CAMPUS CENTER - FIRST FLOOR
